What to do in Yakima

Downtown Wineries (*Masset, Gilbert Winery, Kana, Donetelia*), visit **Essencia Bakery, Yakima Museum, Farmers Market**. *spoil yourself at the Ummelina Day Spa, go antiquing down Yakima Avenue, enjoy golfing at the Apple Tree Golf Course, take a Trolley Car ride around town.*

Historic North Front Street - *Take a step back into history with a stroll along the boardwalk of Track 29 and visit very unique shops located in authentic railroad cars. Visit the restored 1912 Northern Pacific Depot, which now houses Grant's Brew Pub, one of the nation's first micro-breweries, and other shops and attractions located in the North Front Street.*

Yakima Greenway - *if you enjoy the outdoors, this is a beautiful place to spend time getting some fresh air on this ten-mile paved path that follows the Yakima River and includes a string of parks, shady nooks, lake, playgrounds and arboretum.*

The French Hen – *boutique style shop with elegance & class of a European home with rustic-style china cabinets, a glass covered chest and French-milled soaps located in Yakima's historic Opera House.*

The Garden Girl – *soothing garden with a variety of custom-made plant arrangements filled with flowers & herbs.*
